Class 1/1A: "Chicken Little" Combined Test

- Dressage Test: BN Test A, small arena.
- Derby: Cross rails only (Class 1), or combination of cross rails & inviting verticals not to exceed 2' (Class 1A), optional water, no banks. Both sections judged as one class; one set of ribbons. *Trainers must ride HC.*

Class 2: Jr. Beginner Novice /Class 3: Sr. Beginner Novice CT

- Dressage Test: BN Test B, small arena.
- Derby: 325 mpm, stadium fences plus inviting introduction to solid cross-country obstacles, no combinations, good footing. Fences not to exceed 2'7". Please limit to horse & rider combinations that have not placed in any Novice division or higher. *Trainers must ride HC.*

Class 4: Jr. Novice / Class 5: Sr. Novice CT

- Dressage Test: Novice Test B, small arena.
- Derby: 325 mpm, stadium fences plus ditch, bank, water obstacle, good footing, inviting straight forward obstacles. Fences not to exceed 2'11".

Class 6: Open Training CT

- Dressage Test: Training Test B, small arena.
- Derby: 350 mpm, stadium fences plus water obstacle, steps, combinations, winding course. Fences not to exceed 3'3".

Class 7: Open Prelim CT

- Dressage Test: Prelim Test B, small arena.
- Derby: 350 mpm, stadium fences plus water obstacle, steps, combinations, winding course. Fences not to exceed 3'7".

Class 8: Dressage Only

- Intro through 2nd Level / BN through Intermediate / \$20.00 per class.

Class 9: Individual Derby Rounds

- Chicken Little through Preliminary / \$25.00 per round.

Ride Times: Ride times will be sent via e-mail and will be posted on Alice's web site (www.alicesarno.com) on the Friday night before competition.

Entries: Combined Test, \$50*. Dressage only, \$20*. Derby only, \$25*; extra Derby round *if also doing CT*, \$15*. (* Plus \$20 grounds/office fee per horse/rider pair.) **\$15 post-entry fee for entries received after 5 pm Monday before competition, and for incomplete entries (missing signatures, information, and/or full payment by the close date). \$10 fee for any changes to entry after close date (change in rider, horse, and/or class(es) entered).** Send entries to: Laura Borghesani, 36412 N 7th Ave., Phoenix, AZ 85086. 602-320-6613. Entries may also be delivered to Carefree Farms – put them in Horse Show Entry drawer. **Late entries are not guaranteed acceptance. Refunds** will be given only with a vet's certificate after closing date, and we must be notified by Thursday before competition. \$20 office & any late/change fees will be kept on refunds.

Awards: Combined Test – Ribbons through 5th place and gift certificates for 1st place; dressage and derby only – awards depend on number of entries per class.

Please Note: ASTM-approved helmets with harness and protective vests are mandatory for jumping. USEA approved armbands are required while jumping. Horses must be at least 4 years old. Seniors are 19 years and older in 2009. We reserve the right to combine junior and senior divisions in any class with fewer than 6 entries. USEA & USA Equestrian rules apply.

Limited stabling is available at \$25/day, please contact Laura for details.
